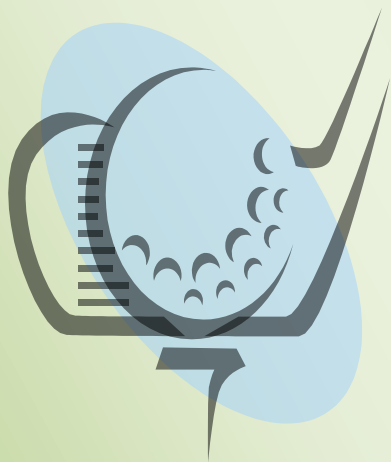

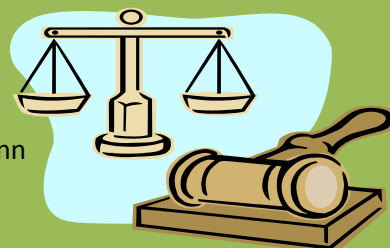

News *from the* Maintenance

With 4 weeks left of summer the course is in very good condition. The ponds are full, as a result of little or no major problems at the river. And given the number of maintenance staff this year the course was reasonably looked after. Obviously, given more employees(poor labor market) we could have made more improvements to the course. But we did manage to stay ahead of any problems.

In July, although slower than June, the greens stayed healthy which was the main goal. Green speed was actually within the range set forth by the greens committee and approved by the BOD. As we move forward into Fall, with healthier greens, any aeration will have faster recovery times. So far this season, we have used roughly 45 million gallons of water on the course. That number is down from last year as a result of early summer rains. We were able to shut off the water for 3 weeks. Even though the rain was a bother with respect to wash outs, it did help to flush the sodium out of the soil profile and provide us with conditions we now enjoy.

With the course in such good shape, I would urge you, the golfers, to be more diligent with regards to repairing ballmarks, keep on the cart paths where we have them, stay 30 yards away from greens with carts, stay off the ropes, don't take divots out of the greens, and rake out your footprints when exiting the bunkers. The bunker rake stands are also an indicator of the low points around the bunkers, where it is suggested you exit.

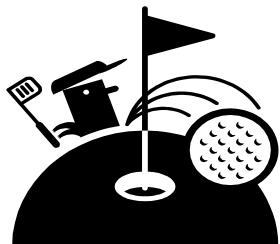

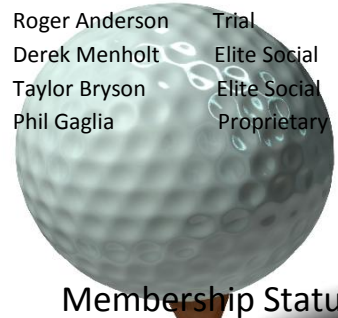
