June progress of the flood clean-up has been slower than expected, at least by me, because the majority of our efforts have been to continue maintaining the course for play. Some of the heavy silt deposits in 1, 4, 7, and 8 fairways have killed the grass below them. We will have stripped or are going to strip the dead grass off and re-sod those areas. Areas in the rough will be re-seeded and fertilized to bring them back to life. In some locations, along the creek, the walk bridges are now too short to span the distance across. We will need to replace the bridges or change the traditional locations of the bridges. The biggest change to the course is at 6 green – 7 tee box where the creek has changed its channel. We are in the process of re-shaping the area to make it look better and to

make it more functional. The bridge going to 2 tee box will not span the creek in its original location. My idea is to have the bridge span the creek perpendicular to 2 tee complex. That way the bridge is at a straight part of the creek, and will be less likely to suffer from flood erosion. The bridge work will begin early in July, as soon as possible. Throughout the flood repairs, my goal was to get everyone

through the golf course safely, then get the course playable, and lastly to get the infrastructure back to better than original conditions. We will be working on the repairs throughout the summer, chipping away at the problems. We hope that you appreciate the effort it takes to recover from a disaster plus maintain the rest of the course, because we appreciate the fact that you stand by us in support of the club.
