# News from the MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

The irrigation system is charged up, with little incidents. As of this writing we have not had to use it, except to transfer water to the upper pond. At the river we have a new 100hp pump and motor. The delay in getting the lower pond filled, this spring, was related to having the manufacturer build our motor/pump and then getting the combo shipped to us. I have had the system tweaked, at the river, to provide better efficiency and reduced electrical costs. At the same time we were firing up the irrigation system we were getting 4.3 inches of rain that then caused the flood that drew

enough attention from the community that we made the local news. With the help of Scotty Keim, Tom Blevin, Dan Vaughn, and Pat Nau the maintenance crew was able to get the debris cleaned up in a relatively short time. The silt deposited from the flood however took a long time to dry out, so removal had taken longer than expected. The flood event was worse than the 2008 flood event, we had 6 fairways that were impacted in one form or another and 8 walk bridges were washed aside. Only 1 bridge suffered any damage, and that was a broken weld on bottom support. A side note: It is time to consider

replacing the walk bridges with new bridges, something in line with private country club status. 3 of the bunkers at #4 green were contaminated with silt from the flooding and the coal slag had to be replaced.

The overall condition of the course is good. At this time I am waiting for the environmental conditions to be safe to spray for the dandelions and clover on the course. It is not possible to spray chemicals, safely, in neither the wind nor the rain. Snow mold scarring is filling in well on the greens, as well as other places around the course. With a little sunshine all will be good, again.
