The 2013 swimming season is quickly approaching! The Briarwood Country Club swimming pool is scheduled to open Saturday, May 25th. Pool Hours will be 11am-8pm. The pool will be staffed from 11 – 8 daily. Please remember that the pool **does not have a lifeguard on duty**. Do not leave your children unattended. All members are welcome to use the pool at anytime. The fee for guests is \$5 per person.

Remember, as a member you are able to have:

- ☉ Private after hours pool parties for members (must be planned in advance please contact the Restaurant)
- ☉ Celebrations (i.e. birthday parties) are always welcome for members at anytime (please contact the restaurant in advance for details)

These rules and regulations are taken directly from your membership directory and have been in effect as far back as 1999. The highlighted items are the most difficult to enforce and we ask for your cooperation. We will be enforcing the rules and regulations to the best of our ability. Thank you.

The Briarwood Country Club Swimming Rules and Regulations

Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and obey instructions of the pool attendant.

1. All members and member-sponsored guests must register by name and member number before using pool. Guest fees are \$5.00 per person. All guest fees must be billed to the sponsoring member's account. No cash or checks accepted. Local guests may not be a guest more than once per week. (The limitation applies to the guest so that the same person cannot be a guest more than once per week even though sponsored by different members). Guests must be with their sponsoring members. Due to our limited amount of space the number of guests to use the pool should be kept at a minimum. Keep in mind that the pool is a member privilege.

Out-of-town guests and sitters: Houseguests of a member and sitters may be guests daily. They must have a guest pass. The charge with pass will be \$5.00 per day per person for houseguests. There will be no charge for sitters. Sitters must be at least 16 years of age.

2. Non-Swimmers must stay in the shallow end of pool.
3. All children 11 years and under must be supervised by someone 16 years or older.
4. The wading pool is limited to children 8 and under and must be supervised by someone 16 years or older **AT ALL TIMES**.
5. Parents will read and explain all pool rules and regulations to the child and cooperate with the pool attendants in disciplinary matters.
6. Following club policy, children 21 years of age or older and grandchildren of members are subject to rules applying to guests.
7. Running, pushing, rough play, and dunking are prohibited.
8. All food and beverages in pool area must be purchased through the club.
9. Equipment and floating devices will be left to the discretion of the pool attendant, but must be checked before using.
10. No glass containers in pool area. Suntan oils must be in plastic or metal containers.
11. No pets of any kind allowed in the pool area.
12. Please do not swim if you have a cold or other infection.

All foregoing rules must be strictly obeyed or pool privileges may be rescinded.

There are no lifeguards on duty! All persons using pool do so at their own risk. Briarwood Country Club will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use.

News *from* Maintenance

The April snows put us behind schedule for our projects and aeration work. However we are pressing forward as the work must be done. We will try to limit the disruption to play as much as possible.

The project work at #2 tee area has been completed with regards to the addition of irrigation, the fertilizing, and seeding of the area. The area under the tree next to the cart path will be sodded as soon as we have enough sod to order. Additional irrigation has been installed, to the new tee at 6, and to the area adjacent to 7 tee. The placement of plants is ongoing and the seeding will be done with the recommendation from the greens committee.

The renovation to the 17 green and 18 tee area is, also, ongoing and will be done shortly. The renovations will include building a new tee for 18, improving irrigation to all 3 complexes, blending in the new concrete cart part with the existing contours, and reshaping the drainage basin in that area. Your patience will be needed, as we have a limited staff at the moment, and the course is coming out of winter dormancy. So our efforts will be split between the two.

Now that the new season is underway, I would like to encourage everyone to use their best course etiquette. Fix all ballmarks, even if you think you didn't make one. Fill divots on tees and in the fairways, with sand provided in bottles, back of golf carts. Rake out bunkers, after shot, while entering and exiting from the low point of the bunker. That would be wonderful, I'll take care of the rest.
