News *from the* MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

The golf course is still transitioning out of the winter dormancy. However, it won't be much longer before the grass is growing consistently and has filled in. The Spring/Summer fertilizer application for the course is scheduled for late May, when the soil temperatures have risen. The course aeration has been completed (at the time of this writing has not been done but will be done before print time). Methods and equipment chosen to do the job were determined by the condition of the various parts of the course. Because of the good condition of the greens, topdressing and spiking were determined to be the only necessary mechanical operations needed. Greens that had some snow mold damage were also overseeded with bent grass seed, to aid with the recovery. Tees, collars, and approaches were core aerated and top dressed. Fairways were verticut and cleared of excess organic material.

Mid to late April the concrete paths were poured at #1, #4, #5, and #7

bridges. After the aeration processes, bridge deck boards are to be replaced with pressure treated 2x12's. The boards are to be screwed down instead of nailing in order to prevent the boards from lifting under dry conditions.

Additionally, the areas around the concrete paths will be cleaned up, to removed the old rock, and shaped before having new sod laid down. After that we will continue to make small improvements to the course.

Pool Season Starts May 28

The 2011 swimming season is quickly approaching! The Briarwood Country Club swimming pool is scheduled to open Saturday, May 28th. Pool Hours will be 11am-8pm. The pool will be staffed from 12 – 8 daily. Please remember that the pool does not have a lifeguard on duty. Do not leave your children unattended. All members are welcome to use the pool at anytime. The fee for guests is \$2 per person. Remember, as a member you are able to have:

- Private after hours pool parties for members (must be planned in advance please contact Angelo)
- Celebrations (i.e. birthday parties) are always welcome for members at any time (please contact the restaurant in advance for details).

Swimming Rules and Regulations

- Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and obey instruction of the pool attendant.
- All members and members-sponsored guests must register by name and member number before using the pool.
- Guest fees are \$2.00 per person. All guest fees must be billed to the sponsoring member’s account NO CASH OR CHECKS ACCEPTED. Guest must be with their sponsoring members. Due to limited amount of space, the number of guests to use the pool should be kept to a minimum. The pool is a member privilege.
- Out-of-town guests and sitters: Houseguests of a member and sitters may be guests daily. The pass for a houseguest will be \$2.00 per person. There will be no charge for sitters. Sitters must be at least 14 years of age.
- All foregoing rules must be strictly obeyed or pool privileges may be rescinded.
- There are no lifeguards on duty!! All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Briarwood Country Club will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use.

Rules

- Non-swimmers must stay in the shallow end of the pool.
- All children 10 years and under must be supervised by someone 14 years or older.
- The wading pool is limited to children 8 and under and MUST be supervised by someone 14 years or older AT ALL TIMES.
- Parents will read and explain all pool rules and regulation to the child and cooperate with the pool attendants in disciplinary matters.
- Following club policy, children 21 years of age and older and grandchildren of members are subject to rules applying to guests.
- Running, Pushing, rough play, and dunking are prohibited.
- Equipment and floating devices will be left to the discretion of the pool attendant, but must be checked before using.
- No glass containers in pool area. Suntan oils must be in plastic or metal containers.
- No pets of any kind are allowed in the pool area.
- Please do not swim if you have a cold or other infection.
