News from the MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

Irrigation system will be blown out the week of November 14th. As usual, it takes 2 days to complete this process in order to insure that we won't have any problems in the following spring. The pumps down at the river have been shut down for the winter. They will be brought back to the course and serviced. Although the pumps are relatively new, they still need to be checked. This will include bearing replacement, if necessary, checking impeller-motor balance, and increasing the impeller size to deliver more water to the course on a daily basis.

Projects to be completed for the winter are:

- finishing the rock and rip rap work at #2
- finishing the shaping and the sod work
- backfilling, shaping, and sod work at #6 green's complex

In addition, an irrigation tie-in will have to be done in order to provide adequate water to the new grass areas. Next spring golfers will enjoy a more generous landing area surrounding the green. We will also be using a rented track hoe to clean up debris left behind after the May floods. As for the course, we are clearing leaves and re-seeding the thin areas left by the floods. As we get more and more frosty mornings, the grass will harden off for the winter. Concerning everything that has happened to us this year, the course is going into winter in good shape.

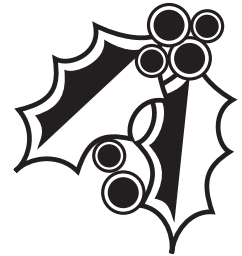
