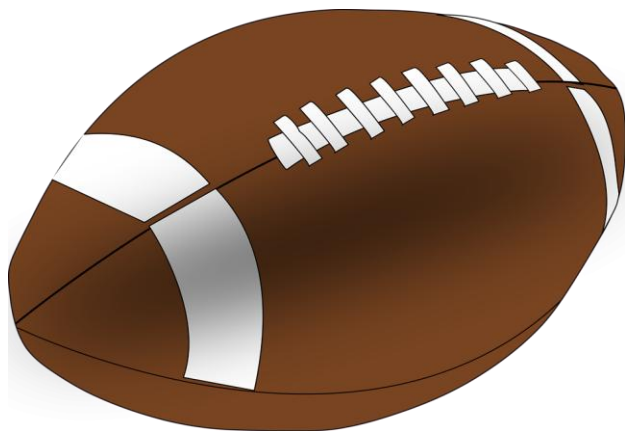

Depending on the winter we have, we hope to move forward on some excavation the next several months to prepare the site for the new pool which will begin in the early spring. News *from* MAINTENANCE

As of August 29th, we have pumped 58 million gallons of water from the Yellowstone River to the lower irrigation pond. We still have 2 months of pumping left to go, which should make it as the most water used in the last 10 years. There have been plenty of problems, over the summer, that we have had to overcome. Numerous power outages along the river, river so low we had to stop and remove the protective intake screens, etc. June and July were so dry that we were exceeding intake, from the river, by roughly 200,000 gallons a day. The forecast for September doesn't show that there will be any relief from the drought, but we can work with the cooler temperatures to get some recovery on the course. Despite the rumors the grass always recovers.

The new surfaces at 3 tee complex have been finished, with the 2 forward tees needing time to grow in. They will be ready for use in the Club Championship. We were able to increase the sizes of all 5 tees, which will provide more angles into the green and reduce wear and tear to any specific spot. We just want everyone to aware that it is appropriate to fill their divots with the sand available or use the sand in the carts.

Areas of the course that were damaged, from the drought, failing irrigation, possible insect problem, and normal wear and tear, will be reseeded starting September 12th. The cooler temperatures at that time of the year will help with the recovery.

Lastly, the crew and I would like to thank Lisa Forsberg for providing a great lunch to us. We very much appreciate that you appreciate the hard work that goes into keeping this place going.
