Hello Members,

The flood work continues and later this month or in early October you will see the work on # 6 begin. We will be building a rock wall on the green side of the creek to protect it from future flooding. Sean will then backfill that area and install irrigation and sod, giving us a landing area short of the green. We hope that this work does not inconvenience the Membership.

The Board has approved the lease purchase of 66 carts and 5 carryalls that will be expensed through operations; there will not be an assessment for carts or carryalls. Yamaha (Masek) was motivated to keep the Briarwood. We should see the first delivery in a couple of days and do not make a payment until next spring.

We have a busy September ahead of us with numerous events; please check the calendar for dates and times.

The bridge at #2 tee has, finally, been reset. The creek banks immediately surrounding the bridge are protected with 65 tons of sandstone rock.

There are 2 feet of roadbase under a 1' x 3.5' x 8' concrete block that support the bridge on both ends. I feel confident that the bridge will be in its present condition for a long time to come. The surrounding area will be reshaped to blend in

with the private property, the golf course, the new cart path, and the creek banks.

The rock work at 6 green and adjacent creek banks will be scheduled for the middle of September, to accommodate the September tournament schedule. The rock work will take approximately 1 week to complete, followed by several weeks of dirt work and irrigation improvements

to the area. Some of the other flood damage problems will resolve themselves as the days and evenings get cooler, and also when play reduces which will allow new seedlings to fill in thin areas.

Aeration of the golf course is scheduled for September 19th and 20th. The only problems I anticipate are the extra few tons of sand needed to fill all the un-repaired ball marks on the greens!
